Dear Clear Creek ISD Resident:

The Clear Creek Independent School District Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call a school bond referendum election on Saturday, February 7, 2004. The \$264 million bond referendum addresses the following areas:

- Fast-paced growth enrollment
- Improvements, additions and renovations to aging facilities
- Critical technology for all schools
- Secondary and region specific capacity crisis
- Additional safety and security for all District campuses

The capital needs assessment for the 2004 bond referendum began in September 2002 by the Facility Needs Committee. For a year the citizen committee analyzed demographic information, studied building evaluations, visited facilities and prepared recommendations for the Board of Trustees. The Bond Advisory Committee and the Long Range Facilities Master Plan Committee added input to the Clear Creek ISD Bond 2004 program. In their reports, the committees prioritized projects in five categories based on immediate and future needs. The five categories are:

- New schools
- Campus additions
- Instructional resources
- Land Acquisitions
- Capital improvements

The Bond 2004 program will fund all recommended needs and will prepare the District for the future. The Board of Trustees and the Administration appreciate the work of these citizens and the time they spent becoming experts about Clear Creek ISD.
