

Lighting

The District intends to conduct outdoor activities in a safe manner. Campuses will have lightning detectors available for outside activities. Campus groups engaged in outdoor activities shall:

1. Train appropriate personnel in the use of lightning detectors.
2. Carry the functioning lightning detector during threatening weather.
3. When the lightning detector activates at 0-3 or 3-8 ranges, terminate activities and evacuate participants to a safe location.
4. In conjunction with the lightning detector, use the 30-30 rule (Flash to Bang) to confirm the threat of lightning.
5. Devise an evacuation plan and share it with students.
6. Post guidelines in areas that are visible to the dressing room areas, locker rooms, gyms, and band halls.

Mosquito Control

The District intends to conduct outdoor activities in a safe manner. Schools shall take the following action:

1. Grass on district facilities will continue to be mowed on a regular schedule to eliminate tall, grassy areas.
2. Playgrounds, playing fields, and parking lots will be monitored and standing water will be eliminated, if possible.
3. Decisions concerning outside activities such as recess and physical education will be made at the campus level.
4. No aerosols will be allowed in school. Parents may send lotions, wipes or pump spray repellent in the original container, with the student's name on the container.
5. Insect repellent will not be shared with other students.
6. Due to possible allergies and other reactions, school employees will not apply repellents.
