

**Fine Arts and
Athletic Uniforms**

A student using a fine arts (i.e., choir, orchestra, band) or athletic uniform owned by the District is responsible for keeping it clean during the school year. A charge equal to the cost of cleaning uniforms will be made to cover the cost of cleaning. A replacement cost may be charged if the uniform is lost or damaged.

Musical Instruments

A student who plays a school-owned instrument assumes full responsibility for the instrument and its care. The instrument may be insured by a separate policy for musical instruments, or by the family's homeowner policy, when applicable. An annual loan fee is charged for the repair and upkeep of the instrument.

**District-Issued
Technology
Equipment**

A student possessing district-issued technology assumes responsibility for the equipment inside and outside of school-supervised settings. The equipment may be insured by the family for the academic school year. [Refer to Responsible Use Guidelines in the Student Handbook and CQ(Regulation).]

**Assistive
Technology
Equipment**

A student with disabilities whose IEP requires the use of District owned assistive technology equipment in settings not directly supervised by District personnel assumes responsibility for the equipment inside and outside of school-supervised settings. The equipment may be insured by the family, or a deposit may be required. [Refer to the Operating Guidelines for the Education of Students with Disabilities for the appropriate form(s).]

Textbooks

Students are responsible for their textbooks and the condition of the textbooks. A student must:

- Put no additional marks in the textbook.
- Report a lost book immediately to the teacher or textbook custodian and make arrangements to pay for it.
- After a student pays for the lost textbook, the teacher or textbook custodian will issue another book to the student. The student may receive a refund for the lost book one it is located, provided the student can produce a receipt that he/she paid for the textbook. At the end of the school year, the student must return the books issued or pay for each lost book and/or pay for damages to the book.
- Textbooks will not be loaned for the summer.
- Each student, or his/her parent/guardian, shall be responsible to the teacher or textbook custodian for all books not returned by the student, and any student failing to return all books shall forfeit his/her right to free textbooks until the books previously issued but not returned are paid for by the parent/guardian;

however, the student will be provided textbooks for use at school during the school day.
