Child Matching Requirements for Pre-K and Kindergarten Students



The Clear Creek Independent School District requires a parent or a designated adult to be present at the child's bus stop during drop-off times and to present a pre-issued Yellow School Bus Card. This yellow bus card must match the one that is on the child's backpack before the school bus driver will allow the student to exit the bus. This process is designed to ensure the youngest bus riders are exiting at the right bus stop and under the guidance of an adult on the way home from school. Before the first day of school all parents/guardians of a Pre-K or Kindergarten student shall:

1. Visit your child's school and fill out a transportation form.
2. Once completed, you will receive a Yellow Bus Card. A matching bus card will be placed on your child's backpack.
3. Be present when the bus arrives at the bus stop. Approach the door of the bus and present the Yellow Card. If the person does not have the bus pass or if no one is there to receive the student with a bus pass, the bus driver will return the child to the school and the campus will contact the parent for pickup.
4. If a student is allowed to exit the bus with an older responsible sibling, the sibling's name must be listed, and the yellow card presented.

Parent or a designee may take a picture of the yellow card on their cell phone and use the picture to receive the student. This is a daily requirement, even if the school bus driver recognizes the parent. Please understand this is for your child's safety.
